## Port of Camas/Washougal

TO: Potential Marina Tenants  
FR: Port Office Management

For moorage at the Port of Camas/Washougal Marina, the Port considers a vessel's length overall (LOA) to measure the length of the vessel's **shadow** (see picture below). This length should include any accessories on the vessel, such as swim platforms, bow sprits, anchor pulpits, outboards, etc.

Vessels may measure **one (1) foot over** the slip length or **four (4) feet under** the slip length. For example a 26' vessel and a 31' vessel would both be allowed to moor in a 30' slip.

<u>Slip Length</u>	<u>Vessels Allowed</u>
20'	18' to 21'
25'	21' to 26'
30'	26' to 31'
35'	31' to 36'
40'	36' to 41'

The Port measures all vessels when they are brought into the slip. Any vessel not meeting the above criteria will be moved to an appropriate slip, at the owner's cost, as soon as one is available.
