



## COMMISSION STRATEGIC AND CAPITAL PLANNING RETREAT February 23, 2018

Washougal, Wash. – January 22, 2018 – The Port of Camas-Washougal has scheduled a *Special Meeting/Workshop* to facilitate the Commission Strategic and Capital Planning Retreat for Friday, February 23, 2018.

The Meeting/Workshop will be held at the Heathman Lodge located at 7801 NE Greenwood Drive, Vancouver, Washington 98662, in the Sacajawea Room. Start time is 9:00am and will end no later than 5:00pm.

The purpose of this meeting is to discuss Commissioners immediate goals, potential port finance investment strategies, Steigerwald Commerce Center, Parker's Landing, waterfront property development, future property development in Camas/Washougal, marina and airport and other discussion topics. The agenda will be available on our website.

This meeting/workshop is open to the public and public input is welcome.

### ABOUT THE PORT

The port brings jobs and recreational opportunities through a 400-acre industrial park, a 79-hangar general aviation airport and 350-slip pleasure boat marina. Grove Field is a small, general aviation airport with a state-of-the-art fueling station and 14 tie-downs. The marina is the largest publicly owned marina on the Washington side of the Columbia River and has a floating restaurant, launch ramp, nearby hotel, fueling station, electricity on the breakwater/guest dock, and is home port to the Dolphin Yacht Club. Acquired in 2012/2018 and in the planning stages, are 26 acres of Waterfront Property. Construction of the waterfront park and trail is complete. The industrial park boasts a 100 percent occupancy rate of more than 40 businesses with an annual payroll of \$8.9 million and is adjacent to
