



GOATS ASSIST PORT WITH INVASIVE SPECIES REMOVAL

Washougal, Wash. – October 11, 2016 – The Port of Camas–Washougal is proud to inform the community that Yoder Goat Rentals will be assisting the Port with removal of invasive species on October 17, 2016. The goats are supported by our Salmon Safe Certification because they reduce the amount of pesticides and fertilizers used by naturally taking care of the invasive species while fertilizing with the goats stool. Goats, also, do well on heavily sloped lands and stay out of water. The goats will be on site for 7–10 days and will be fully managed by the [Yoder Goat Rental](#) company. There will be around 65 goats at the site and community members are welcome to come visit the goats and see their progress. No feeding or touching is allowed as they are fenced by a solar powered electric fence.

Join us at the Washougal Waterfront Park and Trail from October 17, 2016–October 25, 2016 during park hours to visit our new hardworking, furry friends and see them at work!

ABOUT THE PORT

The port brings jobs and recreational opportunities through a 400–acre industrial park, a 77–hangar general aviation airport and 350–slip pleasure boat marina. Grove Field is a small, general aviation airport with a state–of–the–art fueling station, 14 tie–downs in addition to the hangars, FBO and training facilities. The marina is the largest publicly owned marina on the Washington side of the Columbia River and has a floating restaurant, launch ramp, nearby hotel, fueling station, electricity on the breakwater/guest dock, and is homeport to the Dolphin Yacht Club. Acquired in 2012 and in the planning stages, are 13.25 acres of Waterfront Property which connects to a 14–acre parcel of port–owned land to the east. Construction of the waterfront park and trail is underway. The industrial park boasts a 90+ percent occupancy rate of more than 40 businesses with an annual payroll of \$8.9
