Some of you "seasoned" boaters can really help out with general information the new tenants may not have regarding river currents, water levels, and dock and river safety. Thanks ahead of time to all of you "helpers."

Fred and Ethyl, our marina osprey, returned on Saturday morning, April 2nd. We are not sure if they will nest near the Puffin Café or out on the Breakwater pilings, but

we will know soon. No matter where they nest in the marina, you will hear them, not to mention they are fun to watch!

Please remember to put valuables out of sight on your boat. I see several boats in the marina with fishing poles mounted off the stern - Stop That! Gear left unattended and out in the open attracts "bad guys." Please store that gear out of sight. Those characters have to pass right by my boat to get to yours!

Page 8 of the Marina Policy Manual states that, "Moorage Tenants are required to keep their boat, dock box, and the pier or finger in the vicinity of their boat shipshape." It also states that, "Storage of items in the overhead portion of the dock structure is prohibited due to safety concerns." Let's eliminate this problem and put safety first.

One more thing...please put the dock carts back at the top of the ramp so they are available to everyone when needed. It only takes a minute but it makes life easier for all our tenants.
