2017 BUDGET PROCESS

The first step included commission discussion on hangar and moorage rates and the Schedule of Rates & Fees for 2017 and opportunities for public input at both the July 19 and August 9 meetings. Changes to early lease terminations; launch ramp permit; late payments; guest dock fees; slip relocations; and waiting list fees were approved by the Commission at their August 9 meeting. On October 4, the budget process continues and will cover Capital Improvement Projects, and the Revenue and Expenditure Budgets for 2017.

I would like to remind everyone to keep safety at the top of your list when you are on or around the water, and the parking lot. There's a lot of traffic in both areas.

Maintenance of your boat is important. So is the fuel that you put in your boat. Many studies have shown that ethanol fuel can shorten the life of some of your engine parts, such as the fuel lines or the fuel tank fill tube. It's important and easy to do a quick check of these parts and make sure they are in good working condition. Out on the river is not the place to find out you have a fuel line problem. For those of you who didn't know, the Port of Camas Washougal sells non-ethanol fuel at the fuel dock.
