

Some of you "seasoned" marina tenants have a lot of valuable information to give to a new boater. Here is your opportunity to share the knowledge. Thank you in advance.

We all need to keep in mind that the river level is up quite a bit, the current is strong, there are a lot of logs and debris drifting, and the water is still very cold. Please be extremely safe when you venture out on the water and above all, remember to wear your life jacket. Also, when the water is high like it is, please take note of the low hanging electrical wires. There is only so much we can do until the water recedes, so keep your pole tips down as you walk the docks.

I see Fred and Ethyl, our local marina osprey, have returned right on schedule this year. Ethyl was here on March 27, and Fred was a day late for some reason. They have started building their new nest on the west end of the breakwater on top of the piling dolphin. That was their original nest sight in the past. I'm sure the Puffin Café is happy about that. Last year they nested at the Puffin Café dock piling and they can make quite a mess on the docks.

I want to remind everyone about the neighborhood watch program. Introduce yourself to your neighbors, and keep an eye on their boat when they're not around. On the same note, remember to store your gear out of sight and note that the Port does not allow storage of any gear in the rafters of the marina.

Dock carts: Have you ever had to search for a dock cart in the marina? Please return them to the gate area when you are done. It makes it easier on the next person and the next person may be you!
