PROJECT NARRATIVE:
1st Qtr: Staff had first meeting on December 12th with Dstudio 21 leading the meeting with the Cities of Camas and Washougal and Port staff in attendance. This meeting discussed what wayfinding is and how it can benefit a community. Best Practices were also discussed and a future meeting was scheduled for Feb 6th. At Feb 6th meeting discussion pursued on what a trail town is and how that can play into the wayfinding sign concept. Next meeting will include community members to start discussing more about the sign system with them.
2nd Qtr: Community meeting was held on March 6th, 2017. We discussed routes needed and started to map locations of wayfinding. A second small group meeting held on March 22nd discussed the best path and mapped out the locations of signage. This group met again on May 4th to finalize map plans. The entire community group met on May 15th to discuss and give feedback on the map created. The Port and Cities met on June 29th to discuss steps in approval as well as a cost plan and fabrication. Design was completed and is being voted on as well.
3rd Qtr: The community wayfinding group, the Port, City of Camas and City of Washougal all agreed upon an upbeat and modern design for the signage. Decisions were also made following the design to include connection trail phases, bike routes and medallion sidewalk markings for a fun and safe passage to the downtown areas of Camas & Washougal. Currently the Port and the City of Washougal are set to start fabricating in 2018. The City of Camas is working on getting an implementation start date set.
