

The guiding principles will be used to evaluate the two alternatives: 1) the Port retains the property and keeps the current zoning and range of light and heavy industrial uses; or 2) the Port retains the property and pursues rezoning it to expand the range of uses. The Commission will also discuss under what conditions the Port might sell a portion or all of the property.

Written comments on the guiding principles will be accepted until February 19. The Commission will hold a hearing on March 3 to deliberate and decide on the guiding principles.
